FEICA invites you to participate in the World Adhesives Conference 2000, and offers your organisation a unique opportunity to promote your products and services to the largest gathering of decision makers of the global adhesives industry. This is a chance not to be missed!

FEICA Expo 2000

The Expo is being presented as a key part of the World Adhesive Conference, and is being allocated dedicated time in the programme. This means that delegates will have no competing Conference activities for the duration of the Expo which will run from 11.00 – 17.00 h on Thursday, 21 September 2000.

The Expo will be held in the spacious surroundings of the Gran Salo Gaudi and a free buffet lunch will be served in the area to further encourage attendance by all delegates.

Exhibitor fee

The fee will be 4.750 Euro plus VAT (currently 16 % in Spain). This includes the rental for the booth and admission to the Conference for two persons. Please see Rules and Conditions for further information.

Assignment of Expo Space

Complete the enclosed registration form for exhibit space and return to FEICA according to the instructions given. Registrations received from prospective exhibitors will be

recorded in order of receipt. Booth space will be assigned on a first come, first serve-basis. Every effort will be made to assign space as requested on the registration form. However, FEICA does not guarantee that space requested will be available and/or assigned. All exhibit assignments will be at the discretion of FEICA and all locations will be final. Assignments will be made only after receipt of registration form and appropriate deposit.

Character of exhibition

The Expo is a shell-scheme exhibition. You may distribute samples, printed material of any kind, and promotional material as long as you keep within the borders of your exhibit. No noise makers or anything not in accordance with the high standards of FEICA may be distributed or utilised by any exhibitor in the Expo area.

Use of space

- All display material must fit within a 3 m wide by 2 m deep area.
- The booth is a so called shell-scheme booth, consisting of

2+3+2 white melamine panel walls. Posters etc. can be fixed to the melamine panels by use of double-faced adhesive tape, Velcro or other non-damaging fasteners. Use of nails or screws is not permitted.

- Use of pop-up displays are permitted, they may however not exceed 3 m in width and 2,4 m in height due to light rails, and may not extend more than 1 m from the back of the booth.
- Video monitors, 35 mm slide or LCD projectors are allowed within the 2 by 3 m area.
- Nothing shall be posted on, nailed, screwed, or otherwise attached to columns, walls, floors or other fixed parts of the building or furnishing.
- FEICA reserves the right to refuse rental of display space to any company whose display of goods or services is not, in the opinion of FEICA, likely to be compatible with the general character and objectives of the Expo.

Rules and Conditions

The exhibitor understands and agrees that these Rules and Conditions are an integral part of the registration form.

Shipping and Storage instructions

An exhibitor kit will be sent to all confirmed exhibitors prior to the Expo and will include all shipping and storage instructions. This kit will include a three-dimensional plan of the booth construction.

Installation of exhibits

The installation of exhibits may begin at 07.00 h on Thursday, 21 September 2000, and must be completed by 10.30 h. Exhibitors are not permitted to dismantle their exhibits prior to 17.00 h on Thursday, 21 September 2000. All exhibits must be removed by 20.00 h the same day.

Conduct of exhibitors

Exhibitors shall conduct themselves in an ethical and professional manner at all times and in conformance with these rules. FEICA reserves the right to deny the privileges of the floor to any and all exhibitors who do not do so. Exhibitors' badges are personal, not transferable, and must be worn at all times.

Expo Fee covers:

2 by 3 m exhibit booth (shell-scheme booth) including an aluminium construction with back and side white melamine panels, a lighting railing roof, height 245 cm; 1 front-mounted sign with exhibitor's name; anthracite-coloured carpet; electricity (max 200 W); 2 spot lamps; 1 square table and 2 chairs; 1 wastebasket; buffet lunch; entry in Expo catalogue; full conference fee for 2 persons.

Phone-connection, extra furniture, Audio/Video equipment

Connections to the booth, extra furniture instead of or on top of the standard booth equipment, technical equipment can be arranged at extra cost for your participation in the Expo. Exhibitors who register will be given a list of services and equipment to choose from. Extra costs will be charged directly by the official suppliers of FEICA.

Subleasing

Exhibitors may not sublet their space, nor any part thereof, without written authorisation by FEICA.

Security

The Hotel ARTS, Grupo Pacifico and FEICA are not responsible for the safe keeping of equipment, displays, supplies, written materials and any other items before, during or after the terms of the application and contract for exhibit space. Due to the short duration of the exhibition set-up, show hours and dismantling time, FEICA does not provide security guards.

Removal of exhibits

Exhibits are to be kept intact for the duration of the Expo. All exhibit material must be packed and ready for shipment by 22.00 h on Thursday, 21 September 2000. Any material left by exhibitors after that time will be stored in a reserved storage room until 17.00 h on Friday, 22 September 2000. Material left after

this date will be shipped at the exhibitor's expenses by a carrier selected by FEICA. FEICA shall not be responsible for materials left after 17.00 h on 22 September 2000. Exhibitors must leave the Expo space in the same condition as it was before set up.

Cancellation

If the exhibitor cancels before 21 July 2000, FEICA will retain Euro 200,- per exhibitor for administrative expenses. If the exhibitor cancels the contract after 21 July 2000, the deposit will not be refunded. Cancellation must be made in writing. No cancellations by phone will be accepted. It is agreed that FEICA reserves the right to reassign cancelled booths.

Failure to hold Expo

In the event that the Expo is not held for any reason beyond the control of FEICA, the Association reserves the right to retain such part of the exhibitor's rental fee as shall be required to recompose it for expenses incurred up to the time such contingency shall have occurred.
